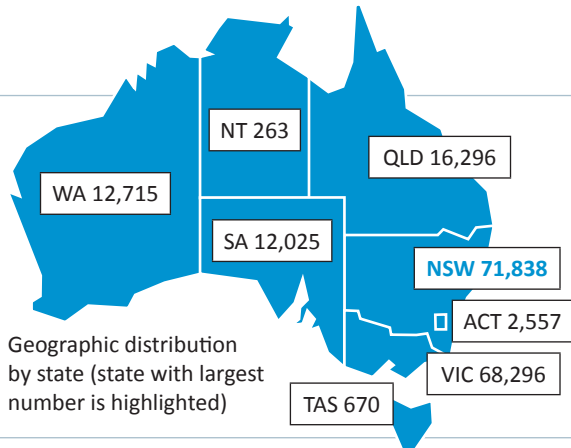


Vietnamese

Age profile; compare with all Australian aged profile: 37 is the median age for the total Australian population

56.5% who speak another language at home speak English well. **42.1%** do not speak English well or at all.

% Higher non school qualifications: 55.9% of all Australians

37.5% had some form of higher non-school qualification.

Relevant cultural considerations

Vietnamese have high smoking rates and research shows they are susceptible to diabetes. US surveys indicate a low focus on preventative health. Their use of health services is traditionally low and lack of a regular doctor and economic disadvantage have been identified as barriers to health service usage.
